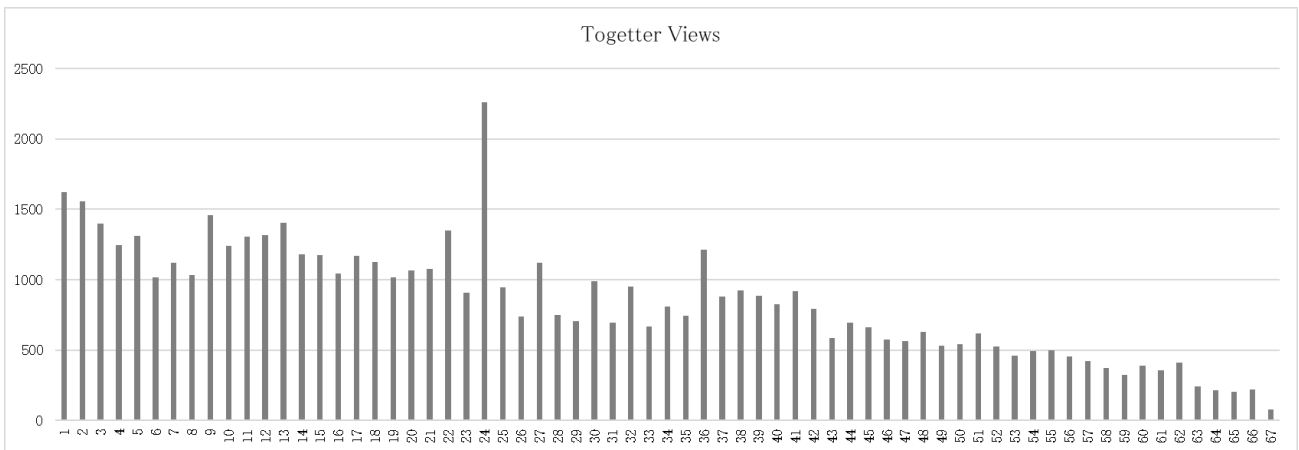

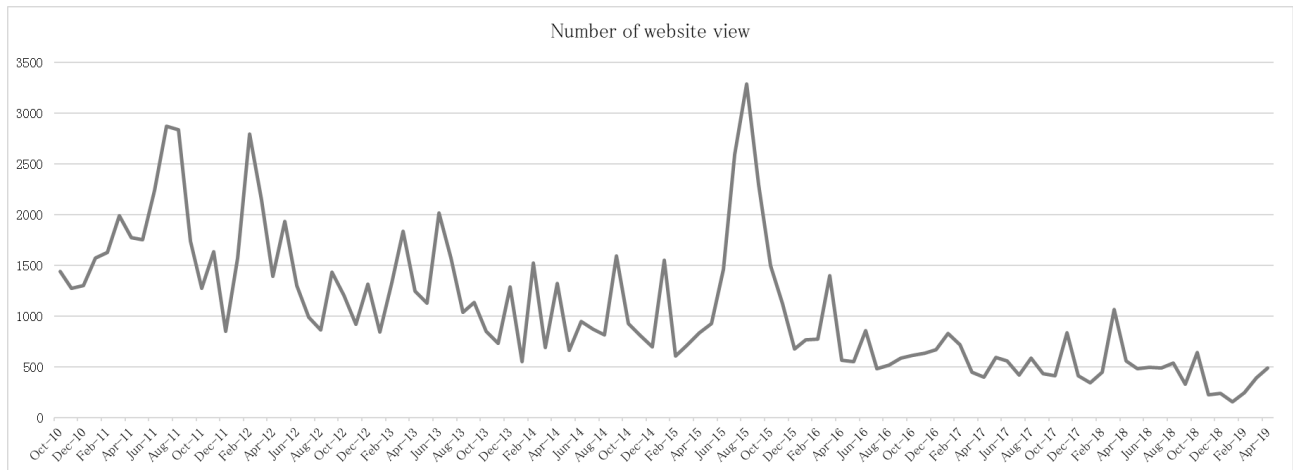
Graph 1. The number of view counts on Togeter per bulletin

1.2. History

1.2.1. History of Group "New-Method" Activities

- September 4, 2010 - New-Method is formed and distributed "New-Methodicist Manifesto" by email.
- September 21, 2010 - New-Method released group's first email-broadcast work "Exchange Intervention"
- October 10-20, 2010 - New-Method held the group's first solo exhibition "New-Method on TANA" (Jimbocho, Tokyo "TANA Gallery Bookshelf") and distributed the first issue of the group's bulletin "New-Method" (Contributed by Manabu Matsushita).
- February 18, 2012 - Hideki Nakazawa left the group while Masaru Kaido joined. On the same day, the group held New-Method Night Vol. 4 "Hideki Nakazawa Leaves, and Masaru Kaido Joins New-Method."
- May 7-13, 2012 – During the week, New-Method sent out a series of works from "Monday" to "Sunday" on a daily basis by email, resulting in a number of complaints and requests to stop email subscription.
- March 16 - April 27, 2013 - New-Method held its 2nd solo exhibition, New-Method '5,849 yen' exhibition (Nagoya, Aichi, "Gallery Ajito").
- July 25-26, 2015 - New-Method held its 3rd solo exhibition, "New-Method Major Solo Exhibition - Weekend Carpenters - " (Minowa, Tokyo "space dike").
- June 4, 2016 – Bulletin "New-Method" No.50 was published.

1.3. Activities of Group "New-Method" and its current members

1.3.1. Detailed Account of Activities by Group "New-Method"

- Presentation of Work

The group "New-Method" releases works mainly by email. Occasionally, the group has organized solo exhibitions and participated in group shows, which involve works related to previously published email works.

- Performance at Event

The group "New-Method" makes performance at events. In performance, "New-Method" members sometimes appear in uniform, casual, formal or specially-prepared. "New-Method" also make talks in some events. The group's performances and talks are conducted in Japanese. "New-Method" announcements are distributed in Japanese and English. The group's Twitter announcements are in Japanese.

- Publication of Bulletin

On October 4, 2010, the group "New-Method" published "New-Method" No. 1, the group's email bulletin consisting of member's works and a guest contribution each time. Since then, The group "New-Method" has issued its bulletin "New-Method" by email, distributed on the 4th of the publication month, monthly since October 2010 until September 2013, and bi-monthly since October 2013. The group has issued 67 bulletins in total, as of April 2019. "New-Method" bulletins are distributed in Japanese and English.

- Declaration of Manifestos

The group "New-Method" released "New-Methodicist Manifesto" on September 4, 2010. As of April 2019, a total of 6 manifestos have been announced. Each manifesto was distributed by e-mail and is available the group's official website.

"New-Methodicist Manifesto" (2010), "Second New-Methodicist Manifesto" (2011) and "New-Methodicist Rock-Paper-Scissors Manifesto" (2013) were published in Japanese and English.

"Third New-Methodicist Manifesto" (2012) has different contents in Japanese and English, but these two versions correspond to each other. "Third New-Methodicist Manifesto" was published in PDF format on its website.

"Fourth New-Methodicist Manifesto" (2014) was released in 40 different languages.

"New-Methodicist Shift_JIS Manifesto" (2015) was published with its English equivalence "New-Methodicist ASCII Manifesto".

- Operation of Official Website

The group "New-Method" operates its official website. It contains the group's manifestos, email works, announcements, records of performance and event participation, exhibitions, etc., back issues of "New-Method" bulletin, and links to archived Twitter posts related to "New-Method" (on Togetter, a Twitter aggregation platform). All contents on the website are available in Japanese and English (and "Fourth New-Methodicist Manifesto" in 40 languages).

The website is located within the personal website of Shogo Baba, the group's member in charge of maintenance and updates. However, the part of New-Method website is managed collectively by the group.

1.3.2. Summary of Group "New-Method" Member

The group "New-Method" currently consists of three members. Each member's summary is shown below. The members of "New-Method" may present their works, conduct research, host events, publish booklets, and engage

with other activities. They also have a basis for their own lives and sometimes enjoy hobbies.

• **Takahiro Hirama**

New-Methodicist. Born in Mito, Ibaraki on February 23, 1983. Blood type: B, Gender: Male, Height: 168 cm, Weight: 52 kg.

Along with his engagement with "New-Method", Hirama creates photographs, painting and music. In August 2010, he held a solo exhibition, "The first retrospective of Takahiro Hirama large exhibition", "[Marin Mersenne + Jean-Jacques Rousseau as Anti-Improvisation] [10-year-old method music] At the same time". November 2019 "parallel Gyeongseong". A member of Nogata Heights since June 2015.

1.3.3. Utilization of SNS

The group "New-Method" has utilized Twitter since its inception. When the group publishes a bulletin or announces for events or exhibitions, the group members make an announcement on Twitter by respectively positing assigned texts in a certain order with the interval of one minute. Each post is tagged in the end as "#newmethod," and the group calls this collective posting "Twitter Play." In a Twitter Play, one member makes a post, and the other two retweet it without adding further comments. After completing all the prepared sentences, Takahiro Hirama, one of the members, compiles the series of Twitter posts on "Togetter" aggregation platform, which is then shared on the "New-Method" website.

From March 2012, the group's announcements are also posted on Facebook immediately after the publication of bulletins and email works, with Masaru Kaido making articles and the other two sharing them.

1.3.4. Meeting

The group "New-Method" hold private meetings to discuss the group's activities. There are also exceptional occasions where the group discloses the content or photos of some meetings.

1.5. "New-Method" and "Method"

1.5.1. Overview of Group "Method"

The group "New-Method" describes "Method" as follows:

"Methodicism is the doctrine that the group 'Method' had espoused from 2000 to 2004. Methodicism is one type of reductionism in the field of art, and its reduction focused on the method, not on the form as formalism did, in attempt to talk of different forms of expressions, namely painting, poem and music, under the universal principle. 1.5.2. Relationship of Group "Method" and "New-Method"

The group "New-Method" explains its relationship with "Method" as follows:

"The doctrine that 'New-Method' espouses is New-Methodicism. The word New-Methodicism includes the word Methodicism. In New-Methodicist Manifesto, Methodicism is regarded as a "reference." We reference Methodicism but not necessarily take it as our principal. New-Methodicism is a different thing from Methodicism." 2. [Status of Activities]

2.1. Activity Policy and Activity Environment

2.1.1. Basic Policy for Group "New-Method" Activities

The group "New-Method" has declared "New-Methodicist Manifesto" on September 4, 2010, and has consistently acted on this principle. The full text of the "New-Methodicist Manifesto" is below.

New-Methodicist Manifesto

We hereby declare New-Methodicism.

New-Methodicist Manifesto is the manifesto of New-Methodicism.

New-Methodicism is what is declared here.

We are the New-Methodicist.

Since then, New-Method has published "Second New-Methodicist Manifesto" in 2011, "Third New-Methodicist Manifesto" in 2012, "New-Methodicist Rock-Paper-Scissors Manifesto" in 2013, "Fourth New-Methodicist Manifesto" in 2014, and "New-Methodicist Shift_JIS Manifesto" and "New-Methodicist ASCII Manifesto" in 2015.

The members who belong to the group "New-Method" are "New-Methodicist" who act based on the "New-Methodicism." In addition, Hideki Nakazawa, an ex-member to be mentioned later, calls himself an "ex-Methodicist" and "ex-New-Methodicist".

2.1.2. Objective Indicators for Assessing the Progress of Operational Goals

The group "New-Method" has no objective indicators to assess the progress of its operational goals.

2.2. Associated Risks

This section describes risks associated with the activities of the group "New-Method" and other matters that may have a significant impact on the judgment of the audience. In addition, from the perspective of information disclosure for the audience, New-Method will proactively disclose matters that do not necessarily fall under the category of risk factors, regarding matters that are considered important for the audience. After recognizing the possibility of the occurrence of such risks, the members of New-Method will work to avoid such risks and take appropriate measures when they occur.

2.2.1. Economic Situations

In fiscal 2018 (April 1, 2017 - March 31, 2018), the global economy continued to expand steadily in the United States on the back of improvements in the employment and income environments. However, due to the strengthening of environmental regulations, the growth rate in the euro area slowed, and personal consumption and exports in China began to slow down in some emerging countries. In addition, the impact of trade friction between the United States and China, concerns over an interest rate hike by the United States, and difficulties in negotiations for Britain's withdrawal from the EU have heightened the sense of unfairness toward the future world economy. In Japan, demand for investments related to the Olympic and Paralympic Games and capital investment centered on labor-saving is stabilizing. The group "New-Method" is at risk of being affected by the global economy.

2.2.2. Fluctuations in the Exchange Rate

The group "New-Method" is not directly exposed to the risk of fluctuations in foreign currency rates relative to the yen in export, import, or foreign trade transactions. At the same time, New-Method continues to monitor fluctuations in the economic situation due to exchange rate fluctuations.

2.2.3. Impact of the Supply of Production Materials

There is a risk that the group "New-Method" may not be able to produce work in the event that materials are not supplied to the group "New-Method" due to international conflicts.

2.2.4. Dependence on Specific Media

The group "New-Method" uses email and the web as its primary media for publishing works. As a result, there is a risk that server and network failures will prevent access to information about the group "New-Method" stored on the web, such as works published online and the archives of email works and performance works.

2.2.5. Intellectual Property Rights

Each member of the group "New-Method" retains copyrights in works on website and other product-based and performance works. These rights are at risk of being infringed by third parties.

2.2.6. Loss of Work

The group's works on website and records of performance by "New-Method" are at risk of loss due to server failure, etc. On the other hand, New-Method assumes that email works are distributed to and thus stored on a number of third-party mail servers, and that there are a plenty amount receivers.

2.2.7. Ability to Present New Works

The group "New-Method" believes that it is possible to create innovative and attractive new works, but the creative drive, time and funds of the members include uncertain factors, and the ability to present new works is at risk. At its peak in 2012, a total of 13 works was released, but there is no work in 2017 and 2019, and only 1 in 2018,

indicating that the ability to present new works in recent years has declined significantly.

2.2.8. Price Competition

Price competition in the art industry is severe, and the price gap between expensive and inexpensive works is being intensified. The group "New-Method" also faces the risk of losing price competitiveness.

2.2.9. Impact of natural and human disasters

"New-Method" is at risk of vacancies due to natural and human disasters or loss of records of works stored on servers.

2.2.10. Member Vacancy

The group "New-Method" is at risk of the shortage of members due to vacancies. The decrease in the number of members carries the risk of stagnation.

2.3. Important Matters in the Activities

2.3.1. Significant Contracts

There have been no significant contracts concluded by the group "New-Method" since the start of activities. There are multiple sales contracts for works, and there are multiple individuals who own works created by the group "New-Method".

2.3.2. Withdrawal and Membership

On February 18, 2012, Nakazawa Hideki left the group, and on the same day, Masaru Kaido joined the group. There are no other withdrawals or subscriptions.

2.4. Analysis of Group "New-Method" activities

Changes in the main activity indicators of the group "New-Method" are shown in "1.1 Trends in Key Activity Indicators" The recognition and analysis of the status of the group "New-Method" from the perspective of its members are as follows.

2.4.1. Decline in the Number of Declarations

The group "New-Method" declared 6 manifestos from September 4, 2010 to September 4, 2015, but has not declared any since 2015, "New-Methodicist Shift_JIS Manifesto" and "New-Methodicist ASCII Manifesto." It can be said that the declaration of manifesto has been stalled.

2.4.2. Decline in the Number of Works

The number of email works of the group "New-Method" has been decreasing year by year, and the group has not released any email work since "Having 'exhibited'" in 2018. The group's productivity on email works is stagnant.

2.4.3. Ongoing Distribution of Bulletin "New-Method"

The bulletin "New-Method" has been published every month since October 4, 2010, and every other month

since October 4, 2013. It has served as a platform to publish works on website by three members, with contributions from contributors. The bimonthly publication of the bulletin "New-Method" is ongoing as an activity of the group "New-Method".

However, in recent years, there have been no appearances in events or solo exhibitions, and compared to the early multifaceted activities, the group's activities can be said to have become routine.

2.5. Decisions about the Future

In an interview in 2010, the group "New-Method" described the next actions and future prospects of New-Methodicism.

H: We think of the next action as the next action, and the prospect as the prospect.

B: We regularly issue our e-mail bulletin "New-Method" on the 4th of every month, and we will possibly release our works irregularly. "Currency Intervention" we made on 21 September, 2010, is an example of the latter. As for the prospect, we have nothing to mention since New-Methodicism acknowledges itself not as a taste but as a doctrine.

N: Now that "New-Method" has been formed, its dissolution is being prospected. And the dissolution will prospect the formation of "New-New-Method".

New-Methodicists, as the practitioners of tautology, see it as incompatible with future expectations and decisions. Tsubasa Tanaka, a contributor to the Journal "New-Method" No. 15, described it as "the nonsense resulting from the tautology makes it possible to realize the freedom without the binding of the manifesto and to constitute an 'ism' without the dogma."

The members of the group "New-Method" separate the practice of New-Methodicism from daily life. It is obvious that if they put into practice the principle that everything is inevitable as tautology, their logic would break down and they would not be able to spend daily life.

Only external indications and criticisms speak of the future of New-Methodicism, for example, such as Daichi Higashino, the contributor of the bulletin "New-Method" No. 28; "You New-Methodicists, 'the 10s' school, may better prepare yourself from now for the menace of 'the 20s' and 'the 30s.'"

On the other hand, since the "New-Method" was formed, there was a prospect of its dissolution. The timing of dissolution is unpredictable for New-Methodicists.

If a New-Methodicist makes a decision about the future, it means its author is no longer a New-Methodicist. "New-Method Report" is written by the group "New-Method." At the moment this "Decisions about the Future" was written, Takahiro Hirama, Shogo Baba and Masaru Kaido became no longer New-Methodicists, thereby the group "New-Method" lost all members, becoming a null group consisting of no member.
